

From her role as a trusted Community Health Sister to her tireless efforts in supporting families through Can-Assist and providing pastoral care to those in need, Jennifer's contributions have left an indelible mark on the lives of many. Her compassion and commitment to community health have earned her the admiration and gratitude of countless families throughout the region.

In the last couple of years, Jennifer has started to collaborate ecumenically with other denominations in Hillston and led a Worship in the Park service. This event is attended by up to 80 people once a month, which includes lots of families, many who are not part of any church community.
